Obituary



James B. Jones, the third of three children, was born to the late John and Isabella Jones on March 22, 1922 in Laurel, MS. He accepted the Lord at an early age and joined the Second Baptist Church of Laurel, MS. He attended Sandy Gavin Elementary and graduated from Oak Park High School in 1942. After graduating high school, he joined the United States Army and was later attached to the 761st black infantry for the American Government stationed in Belgium. He was discharged from military service in Europe, where he worked as a department of army civilian in Germany, Luxembourg, Belgium, and France. His last assignment was in Paris, France from 1957 until his return to the United States in 1965. Upon his return to the United States, James resided in Los Angeles, California and worked many years for B.F. Goodrich. He later moved back to Laurel, MS to care for his sick sister in 1986.

He was proceeded in death by his mother and father John and Isabella Jones, two sisters (Isabella Jones Barnett Parker and Ruth Wilma McGowan) and estranged wife Mae Ollie Jones.

On April 2, 2015 our Father in Heaven decided he needed another angel and choose James.
